I have now added Team Managers and Coaches to our Club site, and they will have received an email from Netball Connect with details on how to download the app and register with a password. Once this has been done they will have access to the team/players within their team via the App.

Team Managers will now need to select the players who will play on a Saturday, 24 hours prior to the game via the App. You will also be able to communicate with each family via this App.

I have been advised the goal for the Autumn 2022 season for Waverley Netball Assoc is:

- to have teams record the players playing each game using the app on the day.
So, adding the coach or manager to manage each individual team will be very handy.

- We will not be live scoring at this point
- We will be using the central timing for outdoors were possible.

As I will now be moving on from my role as Registrar after approximately 15 years of involvement with the Good Shepherd Netball Committee having started as a Team Manager when my eldest daughter was 8 years old and she is now 23, during this time I have had 3 daughters play for the club and taken on a coaching role and then the Registrar role.
